
How and when will I be invited?

- When it is your turn, you will receive a personal invitation:
 - o by letter by post,
 - o by e-mail and/or text message if your e-mail address and/or number are known.
- You will receive your invitation approximately 2 weeks before your appointment.
- Confirm your appointment online or by phone.
- The time of your appointment does not suit you? No problem, you can change it.
- Keep your invitation and this flyer with practical information as you will need it on the day of your appointments.

Note: As most vaccines require two doses, you will be offered two appointments .

The day of my appointment?

Come alone, except if you need some assistance.

- Bring your invitation and your identity card.
- Be on time: it is not necessary to arrive too early as your access to the center will only be possible at the time of your appointment.
- Our steward checks your body temperature before you enter the center. If you have fever you cannot be vaccinated. If you feel sick, please stay home and make a new appointment.

Vaccination flow

- 1 A receptionist will check your personal data and appointments, and will show you the way.
- 2 A nurse will go over your medical history and health status and will provide information about the vaccine. You will receive a card with the identification of your vaccine and the date and time of the second dose.
- 3 You will be given an injection in your upper arm, so wear loose clothing that allows the health care professional to easily access to your upper arm.
- 4 You will be observed in a waiting area for 15 or 30 minutes after vaccination under the supervision of a doctor.

Caution: Do continue to observe the Covid-19 protection measures, even when you have been vaccinated.

How do I get to the vaccination center?

By bike

Bolwerk vaccination center is easily accessible by bike. There is a bike parking spot.

By public transport

The vaccination center is located near the bus stops Nowélei and Vilvoorde Spoorwegbrug and at 5 minutes walking distance from Vilvoorde station.

If you come by bus, show your ticket at the reception in exchange for two free back-and-forth tickets that you can use freely, one for every injection.

By car

- You can park on Rooseveltlaan (Franklin), where plenty of parking spaces are available. Do not forget to pay for your parking spot.
- If you have a disabled parking permit, you can park in the provided parking spaces next to the vaccination center.
- There is a kiss & ride zone in front of the vaccination center where someone can drop you off and/or pick you up. To access this zone, enter the square Bolwerkplein via Bolwerkstraat.

I have mobility issues, how can I come?

If you are physically unable to come alone to the vaccination center and nobody can help you, please contact our infodesk on 02 255 47 88. They will arrange transport to pick you up and return you to your home.

What if I need support in the vaccination center?

You can bring somebody to accompany you through the entire vaccination process.
